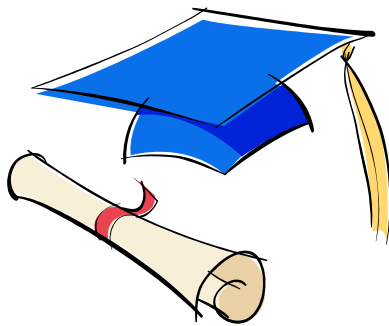

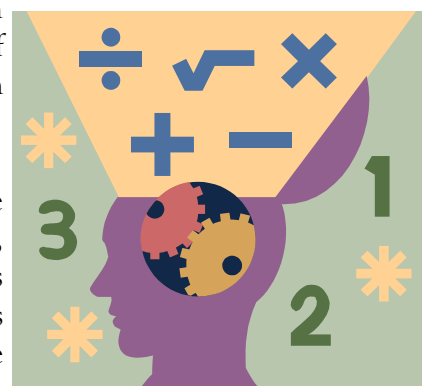

## MATH NEWS

In February, almost 100 LCHS math students were selected to take part in the AMC 10/12. This highly challenging, non-calculator test consisted of 25 questions in a 75 minute time frame and is part of the American Mathematics Competitions.

Danny Duncan scored in the top 5% of all students taking the test in the nation, and he was invited to move on in the competition. On Tuesday, March 16, Danny participated in the American Invitational Mathematics Examination (AIME) –15 questions, 3 hours. This contest ultimately leads to the Mathematical Olympiad Summer Program and the selection of the USA team sent to the International Mathematical Olympiad.
